



2021 Ambassador Autumn Adventure Hub and Spoke - Walking Workshop

FACT SHEET

Program:

Hiking in the Philmont backcountry during the autumn season, crews will enjoy warm, sunny days, and cool, crisp nights. They will get to see the aspen trees changing to gold and witness the wildlife preparing for winter. A trained Philmont guide will accompany your group to areas where you can enjoy the splendor of fall color. Autumn Adventure treks occur in September and October, and can vary in length to fit the schedule of the group.



The hub and spoke Autumn Adventure is for Ambassadors looking for a less strenuous experience while having the opportunity to spend time in Philmont's backcountry. Days will be spent doing day hikes or other other activities or just hanging around the base camp at Baldy Town. After dinner presentations by Philmont permanent staff will enhance your knowledge of Philmont and make you a more effective Ambassador. Housing will be either in tents or roofed housing, your choice.

Sunday - Arrive after 2:00 pm, dinner in the Dining Hall, Social Hour with other Ambassador Crew.

Monday - Meals in Dining Hall, Behing the Scenes Tour of Camping Headquarters, Visit Tooth of Time Traders, Draw Crew Equipment, After Dinner Social Hour and Tour of the St. James (Optional).

Tuesday - Breakfast in Dining Hall, Surburban Trip to Baldy Town, Set of Base Camp, Eat Lunch, Short Afternoon Hike or Hang Around Camp, Prepare and Eat Dinner, Clean Up, Presentation By Philmont Staff, Off to Bed.

Wednesday - Eat Breakfast, Day Hike or Enjoy Camp, Lunch on the Trail, Return To Camp and eat Diner, Campfire, Off to Bed.

Thursday - Eat Breakfast, Day Hike or Enjoy Camp, Lunch on the Trail, Return To Camp and eat Diner, Presentation By Philmont Staff, Off to Bed.

Friday - Eat Breakfast, Morning Hike, Lunch at Basecamp, Packup and Cleanup, Surburban Trip to Camping Headquarters, Turn in Crew Gear, Tour of Ranching HQ (if time permits) Dinner in the Dining Hall, Free Time, Off to Bed.

Saturday - Breakfast in the Dining Hall, Head for Home.

Day Hiking: Baldy Town to French Henry and back (4.5 miles), Baldy Town to Baldy Summit and back (6 miles), Baldy Town to Black Horse Mine and back (5.5 miles), Baldy Town to Miranda and back (5.5 miles),

IMPORTANT INFORMATION - PLEASE READ

All participants must be at least 18 years old, a current Ambassador, and a member of the BSA in good standing and have a current BSA medical form approved for high adventure (all parts A, B, & C) with a doctor's signature from within the twelve months preceding trek end date, October 16, 2021.

Total Cost is \$425 plus \$50.00 Covid Fee. Deposit of \$150 is due with the application and the remainder of fees are due by AUGUST 30, 2021.

Cancellation: All fees are non-refundable and non-transferrable except in the event that Philmont needs to cancel the trek, in which case, all fees paid to Philmont will be reimbursed.
