Philmont Scout Ranch is seeking a dedicated individual to serve as the Environmental Compliance Technician on the facilities team. The ideal candidate will be a self-starter, have an enthusiastic team-oriented attitude, have great written and verbal communication skills, and be willing to continue training and education to keep current with federal, state, and local compliance issues.

## **Job Overview:**

- Monitors the environment and equipment to ensure that environmental regulatory obligations are fulfilled and that risks are effectively mitigated.
- Performs tests on water and wastewater systems and recommends the appropriate action to ensure compliance with federal, state, and municipal legislation and regulations regarding environmental control.
- Assists in the planning and installation of equipment or modifications relating to the environment.
- Participates in quality-assurance studies and tests to ensure compliance with environmental safety and health standards for drinking water, dining facilities, waste disposal, watershed, and all related systems and programs.
- Works with regulatory agencies concerned with environmental control to provide required documentation and/or reporting.
- Must be able to work in both outdoor and office environments.

## **Qualifications/Experience:**

- 5 years of experience in environmental compliance or equal experience in another field with regulatory reporting responsibilities.
- Education or training specific to water quality, environmental compliance, or systems management is preferred.
- Must possess or acquire a State of New Mexico water and wastewater certificate and other licensing as may become required.
- A valid driver's license and a clean driving record is required.
- Must be able to pass a BSA background check.

This position is a 40-hour week, non-exempt (hourly) Grade 2 position with a salary range of \$30,000 - \$35,000 per year based on experience plus overtime opportunities. The BSA also offers benefits to include major medical, prescription coverage, dental, vision, life-insurance, short and long-term disability, accidental death, and a retirement plan.
